COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Committee Chairs listed next to each committee.

COURSE EVACUATION (Sue Britt & Jeanie Riley)

This committee will be asked to drive the contestants and Rules Officials off of the course if an evacuation is required. Inclement weather is the most common reason for an evacuation.

ECOLOGY (Gary Happel & Nick Betlow)

Members of the Ecology Committee will work in coordination with a contracted refuse company to help keep the site trash-free. Monitoring the timely clean up of trash receptacles and litter will be the only responsibility of this committee.

INFORMATION (Sue Mullin)

Members of this committee will staff various Information Stations for the benefit of all PGA Championship patrons. Information regarding the event, the site and the surrounding area will be distributed from these stations.

MEDICAL SHUTTLE TEAM (Don Tansey)

Members of this committee will drive large passenger shuttles to and from different locations on the event grounds when a patron who is physically challenged requests assistance.

MERCHANDISE TENT (Sally Horton & Sharie Mortimer)

Volunteers working in the PGA Championship Golf Shop (an enormous merchandise tent) will assist by greeting guests, stocking inventory, bagging purchased goods and more.

MERCHANDISE TENT CASHIERS (Linda Baesler) Merchandise Tent Cashiers will be responsible for running cash registers during the event in the PGA Championship Golf Shop. Training will be provided with the user-friendly systems that are used to complete all transactions.

OFFICE VOLUNTEERS (Sylvia Van Cleave & Barbara Walden)

Throughout the next year leading up to the event, this committee will assist with large mailings, filing, answering telephones and other duties needed to maintain the PGA Championship Office. VOLUNTEERS ON THIS COMMITTEE SHOULD BE AVAILABLE TO WORK DURING THE WEEKDAYS, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. AND 5:00 P.M.

TECH-CHECK (Bruce Paterson)

PGA Championship Security will ask all event spectators to leave their cellular telephones, pagers, coolers and other items not allowed on the golf course with the Tech-Check Committee upon entering the event. Abbreviated for "Technology Check-In," the Tech-Check Committee will hold the items while the spectators enjoy their day and will give the items back as the spectators depart the site.

TRANSPORTATION (Milt Irvin, Mike Johnson, John Reid, Staunton Peck)

During PGA Week, this committee will be asked to transport players and select VIPs to and from the golf course, the airport and the official hotels. Drivers will also be needed prior to Championship Week in order to deploy courtesy vehicles for VIP pick-up. Following the event, collecting the cars and staging them for pick-up by Cadillac will also be handled by this committee.
