# COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

## Admissions

Committee members sell tickets and journals at the main gate if necessary. This committee will also distribute advanced purchase tickets at the admission trailer.

## Caddies

Members of this committee will be asked to staff Caddie Registration on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday of Championship week. During the Championship rounds, this committee will be responsible for distributing the caddie bibs on the first tee and for collecting the bibs following the contestants' rounds.

## Card Copy

Adult members of this committee will oversee a group of juniors, collect scorecards after 9 and 18 and fax them to various locations.

## Corporate Hospitality

Corporate hospitality committee members will assist the PGA staff in ensuring all the needs of our corporate patrons are met throughout the week.

## Golf Carts

Golf cart credentials will be issued to each individual authorized to use a cart during the week of the Championship. Members of this committee will be asked to distribute and collect the event golf carts on a daily basis.

## Information/Lost & Found

Members of this committee will staff Information Stations for the benefit of all Championship patrons. Information regarding the event, the site and the surrounding area will be distributed from these stations.

## Leaderboards

This committee will be responsible for posting the players' scores on the leaderboards located throughout the golf course.

## Marshals

Marshals will be assigned to various holes and areas of the golf course. They will assist with maintaining gallery control and ease the flow of movement for players, caddies, officials and media.

## Media Center

More than 250 members of the local, national and international media will be in attendance for the Senior PGA Championship. The media center registration committee will work inside the media center and will assist the PGA staff with media registration and the media scoreboard.

## Merchandise Tent Committee

Volunteers working in the Championship Golf Shop will assist the PGA staff with greeting guests, stocking inventory, bagging purchased goods, etc.

## Programs and Pairings Distribution

Each morning, this committee will be responsible for distributing programs and pairing sheets to locations throughout the golf course. Restocking these items throughout the day and collecting them in the evening are also responsibilities of this committee.

## Public Scoreboard

The public scoreboard lists all of the contestants in the field and their scores for every hole played. It will be this committee's responsibility to post the players' scores as they are transmitted via computer to the public scoreboard, which is usually located in a centralized location on site.

## Scoring Control

The scoring control committee is responsible for receiving the players' scores and distributing those scores to the event scoreboards, thurboards and television compound.

## Standard Bearer

Adult members of the standard bearer committee will be asked to oversee the junior volunteers who are responsible for carrying the standards for each group of contestants.

## Tee Refreshments

Each morning, this committee will be responsible for distributing coolers of refreshments to various areas of the golf course. Replenishing these items throughout the day and collecting them in the evening are also responsibilities of this committee.

## Thurboards

Thurboards are placed near leaderboards throughout the golf course. Each thurboard indicates the names of the contestants playing through the hole at that time and where they stand for the event.

## Transportation

During Championship week, this committee will be asked to transport players, officials and VIPs to and from the golf course, airport and official hotels. Drivers will be needed before and after the event in order to deploy and return courtesy vehicles from local dealerships to appropriate areas for VIP pick-up.

## Volunteer Services and Uniform Distribution

This committee will distribute volunteer uniforms several weeks prior to the tournament and exchange uniforms just prior to the tournament. Serving as a volunteer at the message center during the championship is also a function of this committee.

## Walking Scorers

One Walking Scorer will be assigned to walk with each group of players and will be required to keep the players' scores, as well as selected statistics. **YOU MUST HAVE A HANDICAP OF 25 OR LOWER TO BE ON THE WALKING SCORER COMMITTEE.**

## Will Call

Members of The PGA of America or allied golf associations (PGA Tour, LPGA Tour, etc.) are invited to check-in at the Will Call Trailer to pick up complimentary daily tickets. This will also be a place where corporate purchasers and other VIPs will re-distribute tickets. Volunteers on this committee will be responsible for distributing these tickets.

## Behind The Scenes

Sign up today for a great experience as a volunteer at the 66th Senior PGA Championship!

A limited number of assignments are given on a first-come, first-served basis. Committee preferences are accommodated whenever possible.

Volunteers are asked to contribute a minimum of 4 shifts of 4 hours to receive volunteer benefits and spend the remainder of the time enjoying the Championship.

No experience is necessary. Golf knowledge is preferred, however, training will be provided. All volunteers are required to attend volunteer training, approximately one month prior to championship week.

## 2 VOLUNTEER RELEASE OF LIABILITY & BACKGROUND CHECK AUTHORIZATION

In connection with my activities or the activities of my child as a volunteer at the 2005 Senior PGA Championship ("the Championship") to be held the Club, Ligonier, Pennsylvania ("the Club"), I agree and understand that the presence of me or my child at the Championship and any volunteer work or services performed by me or my child for the Championship, the Club, the PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., or the PGA of America, its affiliates and subsidiaries (collectively referred to as "the Indemnified Parties") and their officials may expose me or my child to both known and unanticipated risks of harm or injury. In consideration of and as a prerequisite to the participation of me or my child as a volunteer, I acknowledge that such risks exist and I HEREBY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, AND RELEASE AND DISCHARGE the Indemnified Parties and each of them and their respective officers, directors, agents, members and employees and any other volunteer from any and all claims for liability for personal injury or property damage I or my child may suffer while performing such volunteer work or service, whether or not on the premises of the Club, including, without limitation, any claim arising out of any condition of the premises owned by the Club or used by the PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc. for the Championship or the conduct of any person in connection with the preparation for, supervision of or conduct of the Championship or any practice round or activity connected or related to it. I SPECIFICALLY HEREBY RELEASE the Indemnified Parties and each of them and their respective officers, directors, agents, members and employees and any other volunteer from any negligence of the Indemnified Parties or their respective officers, directors, agents, members and employees. I FURTHER UNDERSTAND that neither the Championship, nor the Indemnified Parties will maintain insurance which will cover me or my child for either personal injury, property damage or medical expenses, and I accept full responsibility for the costs of treatment for any injury or damages suffered while participating as a volunteer in connection with the Championship.

I HEREBY AUTHORIZE a review and full disclosure of all Criminal History records and information concerning myself to any duly authorized agent or representative chosen to perform such duties ("the Agency"). I understand that any information obtained by a criminal history background investigation, which developed directly or indirectly, in whole, or in part, upon this authorization and release will be considered in determining my suitability to work at the 2005 Senior PGA Championship ("the Championship") to be held the Club, Ligonier, Pennsylvania ("the Club"). I hereby release, discharge and exonerate the Agency, the PGA Tournament Corp., Inc., the PGA of America, the Club, their agents and representatives, and any person so furnishing information from any and all liability of every nature and kind arising out of the furnishing, inspection or collection of such documents, records, and other information, or the investigation made by the Agency and/or its agents and representatives. I UNDERSTAND, ACKNOWLEDGE AND AUTHORIZE the release of the results of my criminal history background by the Agency, their agents or representatives will be disclosed to the PGA Tournament Corp., Inc. and/or the PGA of America to determine my suitability to work at the Championship.
