QUOTES FROM: CHRIS WIEMERS

Q. What are your impressions you have of your second straight PGA Championship appearance?

A. It was an awesome experience, and Medinah was one of the most beautiful courses I've played in my life. I thought I played well, but I certainly didn't embarrass myself. I'm close to being able to completing the goal of making the cut and getting better in my game. I know that I can play out here.

Q: What are your immediate plans?

A: I am going to give PGA Tour Qualifying School a try. It's been my dream. I'm disappointed that I didn't make the cut, because if not for a couple miscues I would be right there.

Starting on the back nine today, I had a bad bounce into the trees on my fourth hole (No. 13), and it led to a double bogey. That took the steam out of me. But, I was able to birdie 7, 8, and par 9 on the way home and that left me in a good frame of mind.

I think it's great that we had two PGA Professionals make the cut. It says a lot about the kind of players that we have in the Association, and the talent that they have to come here and play well after commitments at home at their club.
