FLASH INTERVIEW WITH:

ROBERT KARLSSON

Q. Tripping over? Is that the best way to describe you this week, tripping over nicely?

ROBERT KARLSSON: I feel great. The course is a bit of a challenge. But the way the course is set up, you can definitely score here. It is set up allowing us to play the game, and that's really what the players want. The greens are extremely quick today.

This week I'm very fortunate to be on top of the leaderboard. It's a very different level tournament with all the top players. Some weeks you're on the top, some weeks you aren't. It's a bit of a different level tournament than I typically play.

I've had a great year so far by winning the *Deutsche Bank* in Europe.

Q. It seems odd that last time you were No. 11 in the *Ryder Cup* points and you were not picked as a captain's pick. How do you feel about it?

ROBERT KARLSSON: Well, it's a captain's pick. It's his choice. I'm not mad about it at all, and I'm looking forward to this year's *Ryder Cup*.

Q. Do you have a specific diet? Last time we talked you didn't eat beyond a certain time of the day. Do you still follow that routine?

ROBERT KARLSSON: No, not at all. I don't have anything specific. I don't do anything

special because I have tried things in the past and nothing has really worked. All the things I tried were outside of myself, like techniques. Now I just eat what I want, drink what I want and just play golf.
