LEE TREVINO

Q. You've been away from this event for awhile, what was it like to return?

LEE TREVINO: Great. Great. I came here because I remembered this golf course in 1988, but I'm sad to say it's not the same golf course I played in 1988.

Q. Harder?

LEE TREVINO: Well, it's just not my type. It's not my type. If I would have known that they had changed it, elevated the greens, and put walls in front, where I can't, where I can't hit the ball where you call a bump and run, I wouldn't have played. I seriously, I wouldn't have played.

I like to play golf courses, at my age, at 66, I don't hit the ball as high. You have to hit the ball extremely high here. Or you're not going to hold these greens. My low trajectory shot will not hold these greens. And I came here because I remember in '88 when I played this golf course it was, you could bump and run and play this golf course. But they have revamped it since and they have elevated all the greens up high and then they have put these walls in front where you can't bump and run. So it's very difficult for a short hitter to play here.

Q. So what are your expectations for the rest of the week?

LEE TREVINO: My expectations is to play in the morning, if I can wake up, and then I'm going to go home, I'm driving to Dallas tomorrow night and I'm going to watch basketball this weekend.

Q. A Mavs fan?

LEE TREVINO: That's it. Thank you.

Q. You were paired with Mr. Player, both of you are great golf legends, what was it like to play with him?

LEE TREVINO: It's always great to play with Gary. Gary and I are like brothers and we respect each other a lot and I've gone to South Africa and played his tournament and done all that stuff, and but Gary's 70 and we have lost a little bit of distance I still hit it as far as I used to. **Gary's** lost a little bit of distance. Even though he out scored me today, I hit some magnificent shots into the greens and I ended up going over the greens and then I would chip back and miss the putts and stuff. And it was a very frustrating day for me today.

Q. What's your prediction for the NBA finals?

LEE TREVINO: If Johnson, Coach Johnson doesn't find a way to, how to stop Steve Nash, especially in the fourth quarter, this will be it for the Mavs. So I still think that Detroit might beat Miami, Detroit's a better team, but they didn't play like it last night. So we'll see what happens there.

Q. Well, welcome back to Oak Tree. How does it feel to be back?

JAY OVERTON: Oh, it feels great to be back to Oklahoma. I have fond memories here. But not today.

Q. What was, what's changed about this course?

JAY OVERTON: Well, this is the first time I played this course. We played Quail Creek before. And Quail Creek was a great golf course, and this is a great golf course. But it's got a little windy and the greens got a little hard and it was just difficult to get the ball close to the hole. And it's hard to make birdies. It's easy to make bogeys.

Q. What are your expectations for the rest of the week?

JAY OVERTON: Well, I shot 80 today, but I didn't play that bad, but I scored bad. But I think I can play the golf course. We have a nine o'clock tee time tomorrow and if the wind doesn't blow, well maybe we can shoot a good round.

Q. Do you think playing in the morning will be better for your game?

JAY OVERTON: Absolutely. If the wind doesn't blow. The wind didn't blow this morning, it was nice this morning. The greens were holding, but the greens this afternoon were like this pavement we're standing on this afternoon. The ball wouldn't stop. So if the ball won't stop on these greens, the undulation in them is so severe that the ball is going to kick over the green almost every time. But it's a great golf course, I love it.

GARY PLAYER

Q. Today's round, there had to have been some things that had to go right for you, what did you feel that you did well and what was some positives that you felt taken out of this round?

GARY PLAYER: I played some nice shots today, I just had, on the back nine I had two 6s, I had a double bogey off the edge of the green at number 6. And I had a 6 at the par-5.

Other than that I played a pretty nice round. If I get two pars there I shoot 73, which is not a bad round. So, but it's, that's what happens

when you get to 70, you get a few of those double bogeys and things you shouldn't do.

The course was in great shape. I went off at 1:50. I must say that's the first time I played a round of golf in my life where I felt a little bit tired. Never in my life. That's the first time. But that's also due to being 70.

Q. Did you feel the playing in the pairing with Trevino, was it able to keep the atmosphere loose, you were certainly a crowd favorite, could you feel the gallery support with you and Lee in the same pairing?

GARY PLAYER: Very much so and all week I've been here the fans have been fantastic. And it's great to see a great turnout, it's a well organized tournament, very nice golf course. Don't like the tree on number 10 in the middle of the fairway. I mean, I never heard ever having a tree in the middle of the fairway. And then the par-5 with rocks in the middle of the fairway. If they would take those rocks a way out of the middle of the fairway and the tree out of 10, it would be an AAA golf course.
