KIRK HANEFELD

Q. Talk about the conditions. The wind died down?

JEFF COSTON: Yeah. A beautiful day. The best conditions of the week. So yeah, that was pure. The course was pure. The course is hard.

But it was a beautiful day. Couldn't have asked for more. So it wasn't the weather. I couldn't blame it on weather, I couldn't blame it on anything. Other than hanging around with you. Maybe I can blame you. I wish it would have blown a little harder.

JOE OZAKI

JOE OZAKI: I tried to hit it good and then pulled it left and I should have probably laid up a little bit safer place to the right more, but I went for it and didn't make it over the hill and I had to hit it out again.
