BRAD BRYANT

Q. Couple of thoughts on the weekend.

BRAD BRYANT: Almost. I played pretty good, but I just couldn't seem to putt it in. And I hit a couple of shots just a little crooked when it really counted. So but all in all it was a pretty good week.

Q. You ended in the red though?

BRAD BRYANT: Yeah, in the red.

Q. Didn't look like you faced the wind like you faced for the first couple days?

BRAD BRYANT: We had the wind figured out. Had the wind stayed up high it would have been to my advantage. But that's okay, it is what it is.

TOM KITE

Q. (Inaudible.)

TOM KITE: Well, both. The golf course was so tough. It's just such a wonderful golf course. But it is brutally difficult. And apart from about three or four guys, the golf course got the better end of most of us. I played well on the

weekend, I didn't play well on Thursday and Friday, and so I'm encourage with the last couple rounds.

Q. (Inaudible.)

TOM KITE: It's definitely not unfair. But it is hard. Unbelievably hard. Every time you hit a good shot it generally turns out good. Every time you hit a poor shot, you just get hammered.

Q. What are some of the things that they're going to have to do by the time the 2012 PGA Championship comes here? Do they need to change anything?

TOM KITE: I don't think so. I think the course is pretty good. The wind's going to blow. We got a couple of days of it. Didn't have all four, but we had a couple of days. And they will obviously set it up stronger for the PGA than they do for the Senior PGA Championship. But the golf course is pretty good. They don't have to do much.

CRAIG STADLER

Q. Talk about the course, I mean it screwed up a lot of people.

CRAIG STADLER: Yeah. I'm playing well. I just can't get anything out of it.

Q. (Inaudible.)

CRAIG STADLER: The course is playable. You just got to avoid some certain spots. But you can't afford to butcher it coming in like I did every day. So. I did it yesterday, did it the day before, did it today.



**Q. The 2012 PGA Championship is coming here in 2012. What do they need to change?**

CRAIG STADLER: With the young guys here they definitely need to rework these bunkers or whatever they call them around the greens.

15 and 17 are horrible by the green. It's like hitting it out of this brick here. Just put a little sand in there, give the guys at least a chance to use their talent and hit a shot rather than just leave it in the bunker or hit it in the water. Those are your options. Or hit it back at the bleachers at 17.

But other than that the greens are, will grow out by August they should be perfect and it's a good hard golf course. No doubt about it.

NICK PRICE

**Q. I just heard the comment you saying we had fun this week. Talk about the week overall.**

NICK PRICE: Well, I tell you, it was just -- apart from the strength of the wind the first two days, it was great. And I'm really happy.

For a long time probably the last two years I haven't been able to see any light at the end of the tunnel. And now there's a nice bright glow there. And I'm really pleased with the way I played this week and I didn't back off. I had a couple of poor shots at the end of the back nine or the front nine this morning, when we made the turn.

But other than that, I kept going. And I'm happy. I could have won if I hadn't made any mistake, but Denis, my hat's off to him, he played pretty much flawlessly.

**Q. How good is this for your old friend?**

NICK PRICE: It's good. He's been in the depths, he's had some tough times. And he played really well back in the early '80's and kind of lost it. So I hope he grabs on to it with both hands now and doesn't let go.

**Q. Tough to watch though a guy like Romero on 14. What happened out there?**

NICK PRICE: You know, he played beautifully. He hit 2 bad shots in the 36 holes I played with him. And that one on 14 was very penal.

And he nearly made four. But that's what happens on this golf course. When you miss a green or a fairway, you can be penalized very severely.
